## URE BEGINS AT YOUR LIBRAI

**Kickoff Parties** – Our annual Summer Reading Program (SRP) began on June 1 with the theme, Adventure Begins at Your Library. Nine of our branches (Lexington Main Library was, sadly, stormed out) celebrated with fun and actionpacked kickoff parties, attracting a total of 2,493 attendees.



Pelion Branch Library kicked things off on June 1 with a therapy horse named Muffin from Cayce Fire Department, Willow the therapy dog from Uplift Lexington County and a DJing officer from Pelion Police Department. They also had a bounce house and inflatable slide for the 183 attendees to enjoy.





On June 2, Batesburg-Leesville Branch Library celebrated Summer Reading with Twin Farms Mobile Petting Zoo, who brought a mini horse, cow, goats and bunnies. The 245 attendees enjoyed face painting, bubbles and plenty of other fun-filled activities.





Chapin Branch Library held their kickoff on June 3 with Lexington County's Fire Service, Sheriff's Department and Dive Team, along with Chapin Police Department, Mission Lexington, Chick-fil-A and Texas Roadhouse. The 560 attendees enjoyed face painting, balloon twisting and a scavenger hunt on the nature trail.







On June 4, Irmo Branch Library invited therapy K-9 officer Fred from Lexington County Sheriff's Department, Irmo Fire District, Firefly Toys & Games and Mission Lexington to their kickoff party. A total of 250 attendees enjoyed face painting, crafts, games and popsicles.
