## **SUMMER READING: ALL TOGETHER NOW**

Summer Reading officially came to a close on August 14, but the theme of *All Together Now* is here to stay. This year was chock-full of fantastic presenters like Maxwell King, Gravity Check, Lin Ko, Porkchop Productions and many more. Staff embraced the theme of togetherness — planning inclusive programs for all members of the community. Together, we knocked last year's number out of the park and registered a total of **9,821** patrons (a **15.7%** increase).
