Prizes will be awarded on **Saturday, May 2 at 10:30 AM** in each category for First Place, Honorable Mention and Best Overall at Pelion Branch Library's *Poetry Party*. All contestants are invited to attend and read their poem to the audience. You do not need to be present to win. Contestants must be residents of Lexington County.
