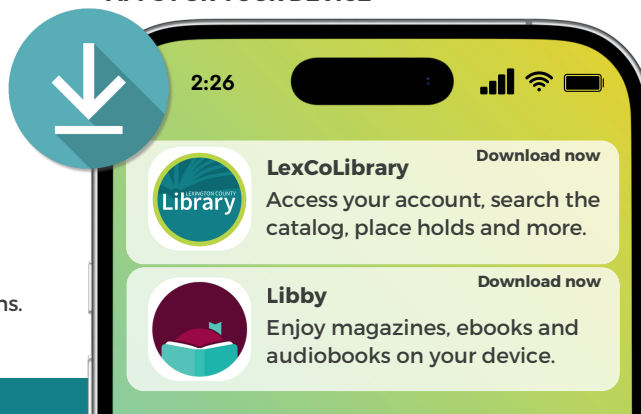

- Property owners
- Students (K-12)
- Employees (County of Lexington)

All others:

- \$35 per year per household

Bring one of the following to any location:

- Valid driver's license with current address
- OR
- Photo ID (e.g., student ID) plus one item with current address:
 - Utility, rent or property tax receipt
 - Voter or vehicle registration
 - Printed check
 - Postmarked mail
 - Hunting or fishing license
